## (NA) Recertification Testing

CCC-Hastings will test persons who are eligible to retest using the following guidelines:


- Eligibility: Must have completed the 76-Hour Course and not worked for 24 consecutive months.
- The DHHS Registry must be contacted by tester to determine eligibility to retest.
- Testing will be done on the CCC-Hastings Campus.

- Testing fee of \$55.00 per person (both written and skills tests will be done at the same time) will be assessed (If test is failed, a \$55.00 additional fee will be changed for each additional testing.)
- Students bring the following to the tester:
  - 1. Certificate (verification) of having taken and passed the 76-Hour Course OR
  - 2. Nursing Assistant Registry Verification Form from the Nebraska Health and Human Services System.
