COURSE OUTLINE

Medication Aide - HLTH 1210

This course is designed to train the beginning Medication Aide to provide a safe way for individuals, other than licensed health care professionals, to provide medications to individuals who are not able to take medications by themselves.

The Medication Aide course is a lecture class. Students are expected to be in the classroom during designated class hours.

Medication Aide Testing

- A state-approved Medication Aide written test must be taken. CCC will facilitate registration for this testing.
- **The student is responsible for the Testing Application Fee (\$20) and the State Registration Application Fee (\$18).**

(NA) Recertification Testing

CCC-Hastings will test persons who are eligible to retest using the following guidelines:

- Eligibility: Must have completed the 76-Hour Course and not worked for 24 consecutive months.
- The DHHS Registry must be contacted by tester to determine eligibility to retest.
- Testing will be done on the CCC-Hastings Campus.
- Call for information on testing times at — (402) 461-2485
- Testing fee of **\$55.00** per person (both written and skills tests will be done at the same time) will be assessed (If test is failed, a \$55.00 additional fee will be charged for each additional testing.)
- Students bring the following to the tester:
 1. Certificate (verification) of having taken and passed the 76-Hour Course OR
 2. Nursing Assistant Registry Verification Form from the Nebraska Health and Human Services System.

Nursing Assistant - HLTH 1200
